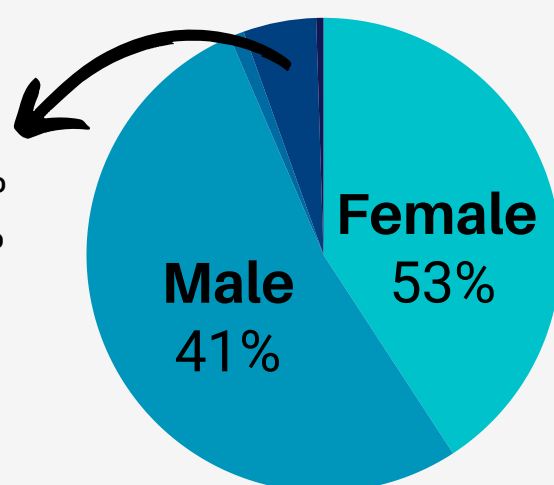

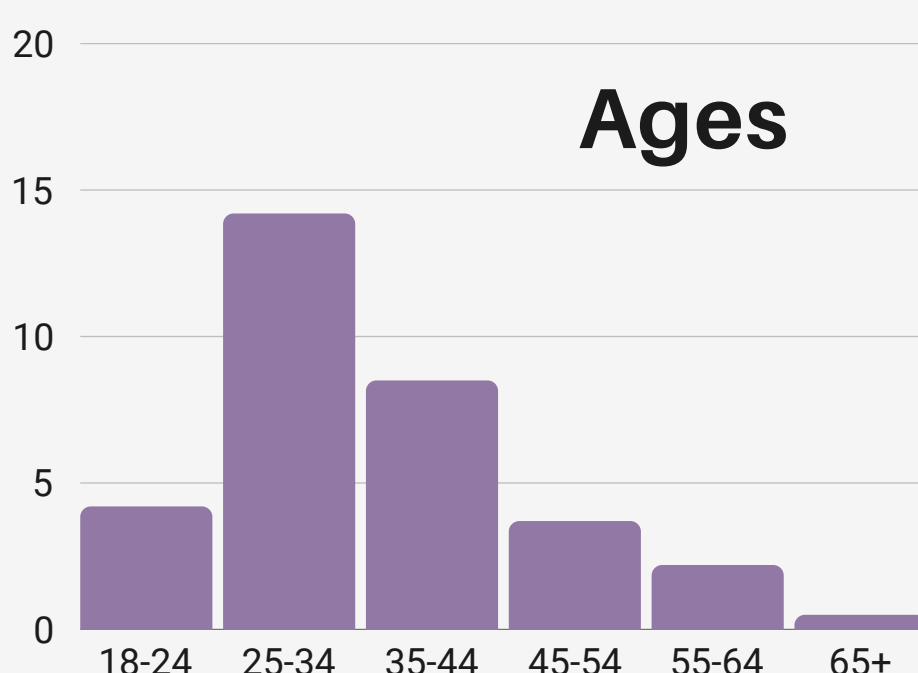

The survey was conducted between June 4th to July 4th, 2021. We followed **Indigenous Ownership, Control, Access, and Participation Principles** as well as **Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Principles** to self-identified Indigenous community members.
