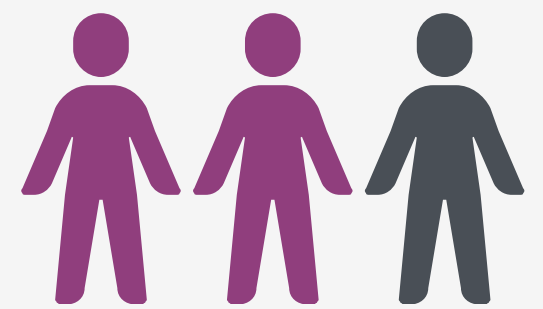
Lost their Housing During COVID-19



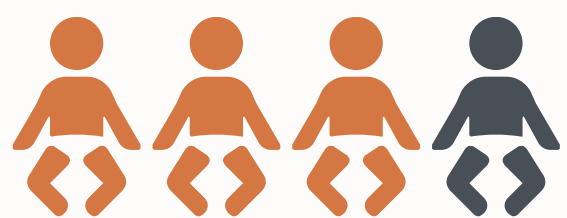
2 out of 3 (67%) people who lost housing knew someone who died from **COVID-19**.

51% were Male
